Wild Noise is the title of the first cultural exchange between the United States and Cuba. The project comprises exhibitions of selections from the permanent collections of The Bronx Museum of the Arts and El Museo Nacional de Bellas Artes, as well as artist and educational exchanges between schools in the US and Havana. The Bronx Museum of the Arts opened its exhibition in Bellas Artes in Havana on May 21, 2015, and the Bellas Artes exhibit will open at The Bronx Museum in 2016.
